INVITATION: APPOINTMENT OF EXAMINERS FOR THE ADVOCATES' ADMISSION EXAMINATIONS IN SEPTEMBER 2021

The Chairperson of the Legal Practice Council, Ms K Matolo-Dlepu, invites Legal Practitioners to apply to serve on the Panel of Examiners for the Advocates' Admission Examinations, as per the provisions of section 28 of the Legal Practice Act.

The appointed examiners will be required to mark and/or moderate the examination scripts for the Advocates' Admission Examinations for 2021. They will also be required to administer orals exams for the candidates.

Successful candidates will be compensated for this work, in line with the LPC approved rates.

The dates for the 2021 examinations are as follows:

1 September 2021	Paper 2: Trial Court Proceedings, and Alternative Dispute Resolution
2 September 2021	Paper 3: Criminal Procedure
2 September 2021	Paper 4: Ethics, and Constitutional Law and Customary Law
8 September 2021	Paper 5: Legal Writing and Drafting

REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must satisfy the following requirements:

- ▶ must have paid all amounts due to the LPC and must be in good standing; and
- ▶ must have practised as an advocate for not less than seven (7) years.

This appointment will be for a period of one year. The Council reserves the right to not make an appointment if it so deems necessary.

Applicants are required to submit their resumés (not more than 5 pages), and a cover letter indicating which examinations they would be prepared to mark and/or moderate and the province in which they are based, to the Executive Officer, Ms Charity Nzuza, c/o Senior Manager: Education and Training, Melissa Murray on melissam@lpc.org.za by **4 June 2021, 16h00**.
