LPC to administer the 2021 Advocates' Admission Examinations

The Legal Practice Council would like to inform all pupils that it will be administering the advocates' admission examinations in 2021. This will be done in terms of section 28 of Legal Practice Act, 2014 as amended.

The LPC administered advocates' admission examinations will serve as the only examinations requirement for admission of a as an advocate in South Africa after complying with section 24 of the Act and applicable Regulations. The examinable content and examination format were done in consultation with all advocate bodies.

The Council is aware of reports that are circulating indicating that pupils will be expected to write more than one exam in 2021 and is looking into this matter.

The dates for the 2021 examinations are as follows:

1 September 2021	Paper 1: Motion Court Proceedings, and Information and Communications Technology
1 September 2021	Paper 2: Trial Court Proceedings, and Alternative Dispute Resolution
2 September 2021	Paper 3: Criminal Procedure
2 September 2021	Paper 4: Ethics, and Constitutional Law and Customary Law
8 September 2021	Paper 5: Legal Writing and Drafting
