

All-Russian Legal Dictation starts on December 3

The 5th All-Russian Legal Dictation will take place on December 3-12, 2021.

Association of Lawyers of Russia (ALRF) notes that for the first time, the Dictation will be translated into foreign languages. Participants will have access to Basic (Russian, English, Chinese, Portuguese) and Professional (Russian) test options. New formats will also appear. That is, video questions from eminent lawyers, government officials and public figures.

The Legal Dictation is designed for citizens aged 14 or over. Upon completion of the test, each participant will receive a certificate of passing of the Dictation with personal results.

The organisers note that the Dictation consists of 40 questions, and 60 minutes will be allocated for answering. Topics of questions: Constitution of the Russian Federation, fundamentals of Russian legislation in the field of criminal and administrative responsibility, labour rights, civil rights, family rights, aspects of international law. The number of participants keeps increasing and geography of the project expands every year. To be noted that the first Dictation was held in 2017 and attracted more than 55 thousand participants. In 2020, 507,174 citizens living in Russia and abroad passed the Dictation.

Legal Dictation was written in all constituent entities of the Russian Federation, as well as passed by Russian compatriots from 175 countries, in particular Albania, Algeria, Australia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, China, Germany, Japan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, USA, Uzbekistan, and others.
