## **NOTICE TO WESTERN CAPE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS**

### **LPC DATABASE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ARBITRATORS AND LIQUIDATORS BY THE CHAIRPERSON.**

The Legal Practice Council (LPC) in an effort to facilitate the realization of the end goal of a transformed and restructured legal profession that is accountable, efficient and independent, invite black, coloured and Indian female practicing legal practitioners (attorneys or advocates) in the Western Cape Province to submit applications for appointment by the Chairperson of the Council as:

- Arbitrators
- Mediators
- Independent experts
- Receiver / Liquidators

The appointed individuals will be listed in the LPC database and utilised when the LPC is required to appoint an arbitrator, mediator, independent expert or Receiver/ Liquidator.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Legal practitioners are invited to submit their detailed resume and specify their area of expertise, number of years in practice and applications are to be submitted to Primrose Zondi at [primrosez@lpc.org.za](mailto:primrosez@lpc.org.za) – **Application deadline is 19 April 2023.**

The LPC will consider applicants on the following basis:

- Must have been practising for an uninterrupted period of not less than (5) five years;
- Must be in good standing with the LPC;
- Must not be the subject of any interdict / suspension or striking off proceedings;

Consideration of candidates who are volunteering to be added to our database will be in line with the terms of the dispute resolution clause (e.g. years in practice, field of expertise, geographic location). **It should be noted that the LPC reserves the right to not list applicant(s) on its database.**

The LPC regularly updates its panel of legal practitioner arbitrators, mediators, experts, receiver/ liquidator which are used as its primary source when the Council is called on to appoint or nominate arbitrators, mediators, experts and receiver/ liquidator in contractual and other disputes.

Applicants must be practising attorneys, or advocates, and must possess sufficient relevant experience in a specialist field of practice. The LPC will also confirm good standing of applicants with our Provincial Councils. **Applications must be submitted to the LPC by no later than 19 April 2023.**
