

APPOINTMENT OF ACTING JUDGES IN THE LABOUR COURTS

1. Acting Judge President E Molahlehi has established a committee to assist in identifying legal practitioners who may be called upon to serve as acting judges in the Labour Courts either for a term, part of a term, or for 1-2 weeks as part of the pro bono backlog project.
2. Practitioners with (i) ten (10) years' experience in labour law and (ii) who have appeared regularly before the Labour Court are invited to forward their curriculum vitae, an indication of their experience, including as an acting judge, and links to judgments written to Mr. Njabulo Ndabukelwayo at NNdabukelwayo@judiciary.org.za.

3. Acting appointments will be at the discretion of the Acting Judge President, with particular reference to section 153 (5) and (6) of the Labour Relations Act 66 of 1995.
