We are pleased to inform you that the nominations for the 2024 Legal Practice Council National Elections have been finalized. The nominations process commenced on 21 August 2024 and concluded on 4 September 2024. In accordance with section 7(1)(a) of the Legal Practice Act, 28 of 2014, ten (10) attorneys and six (6) advocates are to be elected to serve as members of the Council for a period of three (3) years.

The Council that will be elected at the close of the current 2024 nomination and election processes will comprise of the members listed in the table below.

**You may cast your vote using one of the following methods:**

Legal practitioners are encouraged to participate in the voting process, which can be completed either manually by ballot paper or electronically via the online voting platform.

- **Manual voting:**  
Ballot papers will be sent to all legal practitioners via email for both attorneys and advocates. They will also be available at your nearest LPC provincial office and can be downloaded from the LPC website.
- **Electronic voting:**  
The online voting platform can be accessed using a Personal URL (PURLs). The PURLs are unique for each legal practitioner and must only be used by the practitioner to whom they are allocated (do not share your PURL). **The details to access the online voting platform and PURL will be sent in a separate notice closer to the date of the election, wherein legal practitioners will receive their PURLs.**
- This platform offers a convenient, secure, and efficient way to cast your vote. Detailed instructions for electronic voting will be provided via email, can be downloaded from the LPC website, and will also be available directly on the voting platform. The process is user-friendly, allowing you to participate in the election from anywhere at any time before the voting deadline.

While both options are available, we strongly encourage all legal practitioners to use the online platform for voting to ensure a quicker, more efficient process.

**Voting deadline:** Voting will take place from **16 September 2024** and will close on **17 October 2024**. All votes, whether submitted manually or electronically, must be received by 17 October 2024.
